



Policy: Awards - Points Trophy Policy

Policy Number: MTT A001

Objective

To provide the rules for the Points Trophies with transparency and accountability to all members.

Scope

This policy applies to the Records Officer, Centre Management Committee and the Centre Competition Officials.

When to use this policy

This policy should be used when:

- a. determining the points and winners of the Points Trophies.

Background

Little Athletics Centres are encouraged to reward outstanding performances and personal achievements, and are required to have a written policy outlining how the awards are determined.

Policy

Mt Tarampa Little Athletics Centre will have a trophy, known as the Points Trophy, awarded as follows:

- a. The Trophy is awarded at the end of season Trophy Day;
- b. To be eligible, the athlete must have participated at least once since Christmas Day;
- c. The Trophy does not apply to TinyTots;
- d. Participation Points:
 - i. Every event participated in at a Mt Tarampa Centre Competition is ONE (1) Point;

- ii. Every event participated in at Laidley Challenge, Ipswich Twilight, Regional Championships, Regional Relays, State Championships or State Relays is ONE (1) Point;
- iii. Participation at Other Centre Carnivals, LAQ Junior Carnival, LAQ Junior Pentathlon, LAQ Senior Carnival, LAQ Senior Pentathlon or similar have NO (0) Points; and
- iv. Where a genuine attempt has been made, the participation points will be awarded whether the athlete completes the event.
- e. Equalling or Exceeding Season Best Points:
 - i. At any carnival, ours, LAQ or other recognised by LAA is FIVE (5) Points; and
 - ii. These points are in addition to participation points.
- f. Equalling or Exceeding Other Best Performances or Records Points:
 - i. There are NO (0) additional points for exceeding Centre, Meet, Regional, State, Australian, Oceania, World or Other Records.
- g. Schools and Non-LAQ Events Points:
 - i. No (0) Points are available.
- h. Display of Points:
 - i. Points Tables are displayed at the end of September, October, November and December;
 - ii. Points for each athlete will be displayed for anyone within the centre to view; and
 - iii. The December update will be the last update made public prior to Trophy Day.
- i. The boy and girl in each age group with the most points will receive the trophy.

This policy was approved by a majority of votes at the Centre Management Committee Meeting of the Centre on 25 March 2017.

Date of Review

This policy shall be reviewed at or before the Centre Committee Meeting of **May 2020**.



Policy: Awards - Of the Year Trophy Policy

Objective

To provide the rules for the Of the Year Trophies with transparency and accountability to all members.

Scope

This policy applies to the Records Officer, Centre Management Committee and the Centre Competition Officials.

When to use this policy

This policy should be used when:

- a. determining the points and winners of the Of The Year Trophies.

Background

Little Athletics Centres are encouraged to reward outstanding performances and personal achievements, and a required to have a written policy outlining how the awards are determined.

Policy

Mt Tarampa Little Athletics Centre will have a trophy, known as the Of The Year Trophy, with points awarded as follows:

- a. The Trophy is awarded at the end of season Trophy Day;
- b. To be eligible, the athlete must have participated at least once since Christmas Day;
- c. The Trophy does not apply to TinyTots;
- d. There will be one trophy per event discipline group, giving a total of SIX (6) Trophies;
- e. The event discipline groups are:
 - i. Sprints;
 - ii. Distance;

- iii. Hurdles;
 - iv. Walks;
 - v. Jumps; and
 - vi. Throws;
 - vii. With the events as defined by LAQ.
- f. Generally, the award is compared with the McDonalds Blue Level for the event, where:
- i. The winner of a track event is the fastest compared to the McDonalds Blue Level; and
 - ii. The winner of a field event is the furthest compared to the McDonalds Blue Level;
- g. Specifically, the award is calculated as:
- i. $\frac{\textit{Season Best}}{\textit{Blue Level}} \times 100$;
 - ii. The winner for a track event group will have the lowest score; and
 - iii. The winner for a field event group will have the highest score.
- h. For clarity, the award is for the best performance in each discipline, not the best athlete across the discipline.

This policy was approved by a majority of votes at the Centre Management Committee Meeting of the Centre on 25 March 2017.

Policy: Awards - Sportsmanship Trophy Policy

Objective

To provide the rules for the Sportsmanship Trophies with transparency and accountability to all members.

Scope

This policy applies to the Records Officer, Centre Management Committee and the Centre Competition Officials.

When to use this policy

This policy should be used when:

- a. determining the points and winners of the Sportsmanship Trophies.

Background

Little Athletics Centres are encouraged to reward outstanding performances and personal achievements, and are required to have a written policy outlining how the awards are determined.

Policy

Mt Tarampa Little Athletics Centre will have a trophy, known as the Sportsmanship Trophy, awarded as follows:

- a. The Trophy is awarded at the end of season Trophy Day;
- b. To be eligible, the athlete must have participated at least once since Christmas Day;
- c. There will be two trophies, one for a boy and one for a girl;
- d. The athletes can be from any age group (excluding TinyTots);
- e. The winner is decided by the Centre Management Committee, having regard to:
 - i. Their attendance during the season,
 - ii. Their participation during the season,

- iii. Their personal development during the season,
- iv. Their attitude during the season, and
- v. Their assistance to the centre during the season,
- f. The decision cannot have regard to:
 - i. Their performances (winning or losing) during the season,
 - ii. Any matter from a previous season.

Date of Resolution

This policy was approved by a majority of votes at the Centre Management Committee Meeting of the Centre on 25 March 2017.

Date of Review

This policy shall be reviewed at or before the Centre Committee Meeting of **May 2020**.



Policy: Awards - General Trophy Day Awards Policy

Objective

To provide the rules for the Other Trophies at Trophy Day with transparency and accountability to all members.

Scope

This policy applies to the Records Officer, Centre Management Committee and the Centre Competition Officials.

When to use this policy

This policy should be used when:

- a. determining the winners of other trophies at Trophy Day.

Background

Little Athletics Centres are encouraged to reward outstanding performances and personal achievements, and are required to have a written policy outlining how the awards are determined.

Policy

Mt Tarampa Little Athletics Centre will provide other trophies at Trophy Day:

- a. The Trophies are awarded at the end of season Trophy Day;
- b. To be eligible, the athlete must have participated at least once since Christmas Day;
- c. Every eligible athlete will receive a trophy;
- d. Every athlete will receive a certificate with their Season Best Performances;
- e. If an athlete does not receive a McDonalds Achievement Award, that athlete will receive a McDonalds Voucher/Encouragement Award (or similar);
- f. Each athlete will receive any outstanding awards from the Season at Trophy Day; and;

- g. An athlete that is ineligible for a Trophy may receive a Trophy at the discretion of the Centre Management Committee.

Date of Resolution

This policy was approved by a majority of votes at the Centre Management Committee Meeting of the Centre on 25 March 2017.

Date of Review

This policy shall be reviewed at or before the Centre Committee Meeting of **May 2020**.



Policy: Awards - McDonalds Achievement Awards Policy

Mt Tarampa Little Athletics Centre will utilise the McDonalds Achievement Awards, under the rules and guidelines set by LAQ.

Policy: Awards - Graduating Athletes Trophy Policy

- a. determining the recipients of Graduation Trophies.

Background

Little Athletics Centres are encouraged to reward outstanding performances and personal achievements, and are required to have a written policy outlining how the awards are determined.

Policy

Mt Tarampa Little Athletics Centre will have a trophy, known as the Graduation Trophy, awarded as follows:

- a. The Trophy is awarded at the end of season Trophy Day;
- b. The athlete must be from the final year of the centre (i.e. Under17); and
- c. The athlete has reasonably participated during the season with the centre.

This policy was approved by a majority of votes at the Centre Management Committee Meeting of the Centre on 25 March 2017.

This policy shall be reviewed at or before the Centre Committee Meeting of **May 2020**.

Little Athletics Centres are encouraged to reward outstanding performances and personal achievements, and are required to have a written policy outlining how the awards are determined.

Policy

Mt Tarampa Little Athletics Centre will provide Centre Records Certificates, awarded as follows:

- a. If an athlete is deemed to have established (or set) a new centre record; or*
- b. If an athlete is deemed to have broken a centre record; then*
- c. That athlete will receive a certificate for their efforts, presented at the centre.*
